


Learning Modules

To Create a Learning Module

1. In the Build tab, click on the Learning Module tool in the Course Tools menu.
2. Click on the Create Learning Module button.



To Add Content to an Existing Module

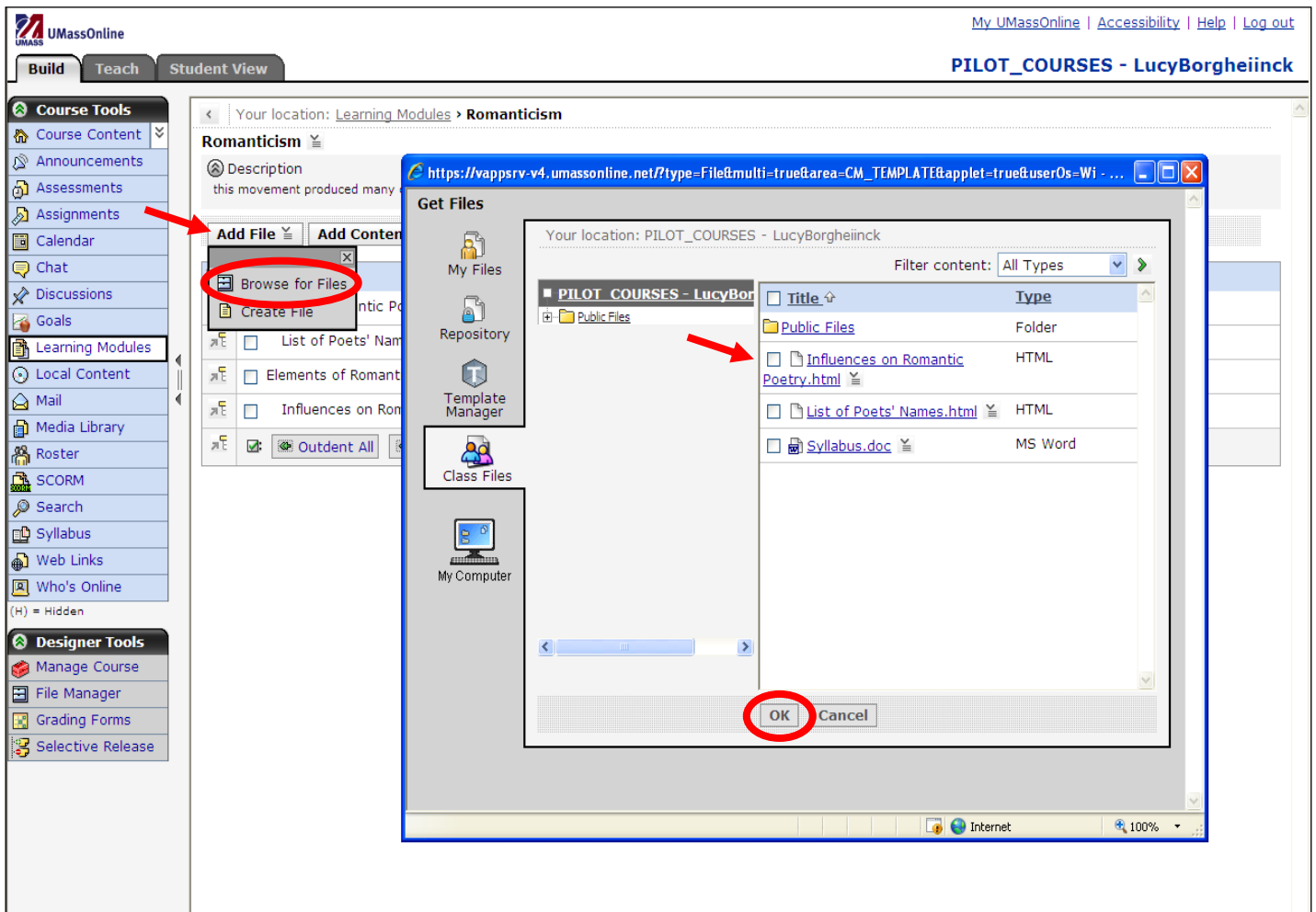
1. Click on the Learning Module tool.

3. If you want to add a file that is already on your computer or in your Blackboard Vista 8.0.1 My Files, click on Add File and then Browse for Files.
4. Click on the name of the file or the checkbox next to it and then click OK to upload the file.



5. If you wish to add a course tool, such as a quiz or discussion, click on Add Content Link. From the drop-down menu click on the type of tool you wish to add. The window will expand for you to choose the type of content you wish to add. If you wish to use existing content, click on it and then click the Add Selected button. If you wish to create new content, click on the corresponding Create button.
